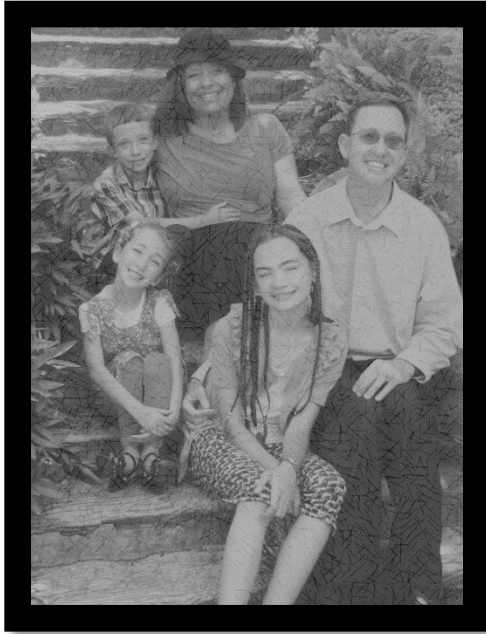


## Ashley and Tracey Hord Deputation Schedule - May 14 to June 3, 2018

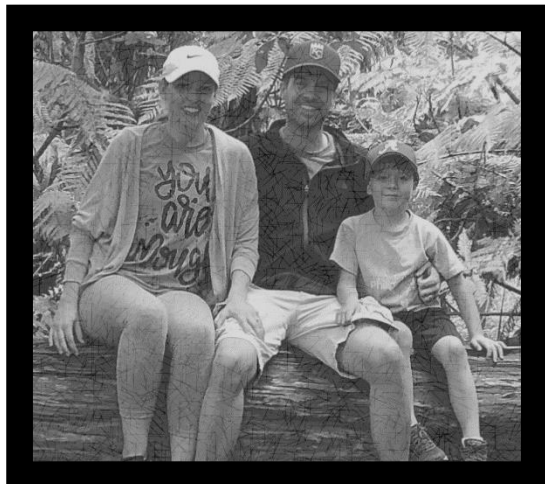

Jaron, Elizabeth, and Quentin Graham serve as missionaries in Hamilton, New Zealand. Together, they pastor Crossroads Church, a diverse group of people from 10 different cultures ranging in age from 1 to 90, who are learning together what it means to be the body of believers.

Jaron and Elizabeth have also developed and give leadership to Nazarene Theological College-Auckland (NTC-AKL) in partnership with NTC-Brisbane. NTC-AKL provides affordable and accessible Wesleyan pastoral education on the ground in New Zealand. Currently, the NTC-AKL students represent more than six different cultures, none of whom speak English as their first language.

Jaron also serves as a district Network Leader, giving leadership, placing pastors, casting vision, and supporting the churches outside of Auckland. Elizabeth is the district SDMI Chairperson and represents NTC-AKL on the regional theological education visioning team.

Jaron is a graduate of Southern Nazarene University and Nazarene Theological Seminary. Elizabeth is a graduate of MidAmerica Nazarene University, Baker University, and Point Loma Nazarene University. 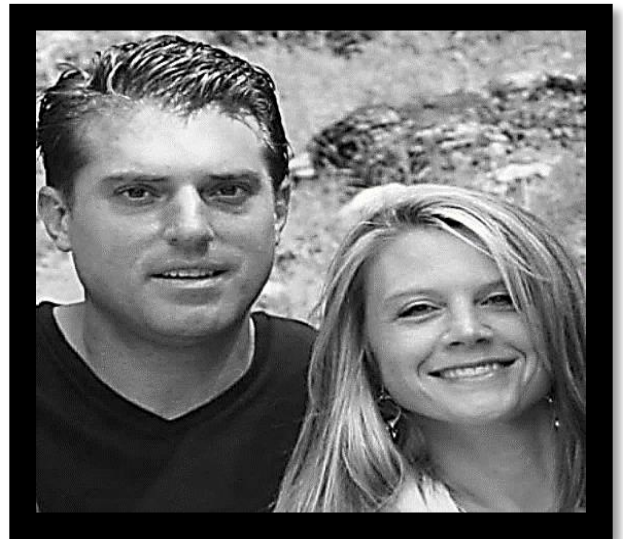

Barry is the Field Strategy Coordinator for the Field and Charlie works with finances and local ministries, especially NYI. They also work with work and witness, Church development, and the Jesus Film.

Before heading back to the South American Region, the Carneys served in Hot Springs, Arkansas at First Church of the Nazarene where Barry was the administrative and youth pastor. The Carneys served as global missionaries for 8 years; serving the Church of the Nazarene in El Paso as the Work and Witness Coordinators for USA/Canada with an emphasis on the border of Mexico and as the Work and Witness coordinators for the Church of the Nazarene in Argentina from 2001 – 2006.
