

Why do we give to the World Evangelism Fund?

The **World Evangelism Fund** goes directly toward accomplishing the mission of the Church of the Nazarene: to make Christlike disciples in the nations. It is the funding that operates the Church of the Nazarene and its entire mission effort, from the operation of the Global Ministry Center to districts and churches around the world.

The World Evangelism Fund provides:

- Full-time missionaries with a salary, medical insurance, pension, and other necessities such as housing and travel.
- Literature in more than 90 languages, including resources for pastors and Bible-based teaching materials for children, youth, and adults.
- Support for starting new churches around the world and developing training resources for equipping pastors and church leaders.
- Support for ministries at the Global Ministry Center, including the work of the Board of General Superintendents, Nazarene Youth International, Sunday School and Discipleship Ministries International, Global Mission, Nazarene Missions International, the International Board of Education, and Stewardship Ministries.
- Base support for ministries such as Nazarene Compassionate Ministries and JESUS Film Harvest Partners.

The World Evangelism Fund is fueled by the generosity of Nazarenes around the world, giving generously and sacrificially so that, together, we can continue the mission of making Christlike disciples in the nation.
